## Build a full internet website in HTML

# 1 Summary of previous courses

In HTML, we have been working over the last few weeks on:

- 1. The concept of tags;
- 2. The layout: titles, paragraphs, text in italics and bold;
- 3. Hypertext links, to go from one HTML page to another;
- 4. Lists: bullet lists, numbered lists;
- 5. Tables: management of rows, columns, borders (also background colors, merging of rows or columns);
- 6. Images: insertion, resizing, alignment (centered on the page, or aligned on an edge with the text in outline).

## 2 4-weeks project

We will now create a complete mini-website using all of our techniques.

- Project duration: 4 weeks;
- At least 4 different web pages, which must have links to each other (and to the rest of the web);
- Your website must include all that have been worked during previous lessons (see the previous section which summarizes everything);
- The site must indicate the sources from which the information and data come;
- The site must be correctly written (no abbreviations, use a spell checker...);
- At the end of the project, everyone will present it to the class.

# 3 Project ideas

### 3.1 Wikipedia page

You create a Wikipedia-style page about a person (or a group of people like an association, etc.) that you like. You describe the people, their story, the highlights...

### 3.2 Restaurant / store

You create the web page of a restaurant, a store... which must describe the opening hours, how to contact the store, what is sold...

#### 3.3 Course

You create the internet page for one of your courses (or a course from last year). You describe the different chapters, what you saw, what you liked...

#### 3.4 Event

You organize an event (concert, birthday, conference...) and you describe the event, the dates, how to contact the team, etc.

## 3.5 Sports, leisure club

You create the home page of a sports club (baseball, volleyball...) or a hobby (chess, board games...). You describe your activity, the meeting place, how to contact you, etc.

## 3.6 Artist page

You present your works of art with numerous commented photos, where you intend to exhibit your works, what are the techniques used.  $\dots$
